Introduction

This issue of Core Brief provides information on the appointment of new Board Members and the Vice Chair of NHSGGC.

Member Appointments to Greater Glasgow & Clyde NHS Board

The Cabinet Secretary for Health and Sport has announced the appointment of Alan Cowan, Jeanette Donnelly, Jacqueline Forbes, John Legg, John Matthews, Anne-Marie Monaghan, Ian Ritchie and Rona Sweeney to Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS Board.

All appointments will be for four years from 1 July 2016 to 30 June 2020.

These appointments are part-time and attract a remuneration of £8,169 for a time commitment of 1 day per week.

All appointments are made on merit and political activity plays no part in the selection process. However, in accordance with the original Nolan recommendations, there is a requirement for appointees' political activity within the last five years (if there is any to be declared) to be made public. The appointees have had no political activity in the last 5 years.

These appointments are regulated by the Commissioner for Ethical Standards in Public Life in Scotland.
