Acceptable Use Policy

Because of growing cyber threats and issues around data loss and also to support General Data Protection Requirements (GDPR), Network Information Systems Directive (NISD), Scottish Government's Cyber Strategy and Scottish Government eHealth security framework, NHSGGC has a new suite of security policies and approach to managing Information Security.

It covers the dos and dont's for all NHSGGC users when on our system or network.

All NHSGGC staff should read and comply with the new [Acceptable Use Policy](#) which can be found under [Information Governance and Information Technology Security Framework](#) page on StaffNet.

Over the next 12 months, the acceptable use policy will be delivered to all users in five stages using on-screen pop-ups, when you log on to the network. The first stage will be an Acceptable Use Policy baseline assessment and will be delivered from October 2018. You will have options to defer the policy acceptance but you will need to read and accept the policy within four weeks. It is expected that each section will take about five minutes.
