Introduction

This issue lets staff know about the barrier at the car park at the RAH and reminds staff to get their Chairman's Awards in.

RAH barrier at main patient and visitor car park

The RAH site offers both patient and visitor car parking and staff parking (permit, non permit and car share) and every effort has been made to increase parking spaces for staff including the successful implementation of car share permits.

In response to increasing concerns from patients and visitors to the RAH who are unable to access parking, which often results in missed appointments and increased anxiety, a decision has been taken to introduce a system within the main patient and visitor car park where access at peak times will be controlled with the use of a barrier system. This car park is for staff permit holders and patients/visitors only; staff non permit holders can park without limit of time utilising the large number of spaces throughout the RAH site.

The barrier will be in operation at the entrance to the main patient and visitor car park commencing Tuesday 7 May 2019 during peak times i.e. 6.30am – 9.30am and 2.00pm to 3.30pm.

Travel Plan events have been hosted across the site where staff could discuss in detail their travel requirements. Staff who wish to make an application for a car share permit should contact the Facilities Department for further information.
