CPR – saves lives

The Scottish Government Save a Life for Scotland campaign, involving staff, the public, voluntary sector and communities, aims to equip people to be ready to start CPR, the cornerstone to saving lives from out of hospital cardiac arrest.

Our resuscitation training team are supporting this campaign by holding training sessions on 19 June which will give staff the opportunity to learn the life saving skills of CPR and empower them to realise that they have the power to save a life through their hands.
