Equality & Human Rights e-learning module

There has been a significant increase in the uptake of the introductory equality and human rights e-learning module since it was included in the suite of mandatory e-modules.

Currently 71% of the workforce has successfully completed the e-learning module equating to around 28,400 employees, compared to 2,906 in 2017/18. This figure should continue to increase ensuring that all staff understand their obligations under the Equality Act (2010).

The module has been revised to make it more interactive and covering broader issues including hate crime, human rights in health and social care and promotion of staff engagement groups e.g. the lesbian, gay, bi and transgender staff network.
