The Workplace Equality Index, the definitive benchmarking tool for employers to measure their progress on lesbian, gay, bi and trans inclusion, ranks NHSGGC as one of the top engagers with LGBT+ communities across all sectors, scoring above the average of the top 100 employers in the UK. We are the top engager with LGBT+ communities in the health sector in Scotland.

In addition, Sandyford were awarded the LGBT Charter Gold Level in April. Youth Health Service (North West) and Civic Realm (South) achieved Bronze Level.
