Staff flu vaccination

We are urging all staff to fight flu this winter by getting their FREE flu vaccination as soon as possible. Staff are asked to register online prior to attending for vaccination via the new Staff Flu Registration Form <https://ggcflu.azurewebsites.net/>

Please note, staff will be asked to provide their NHS payroll number. You can find your payroll number on your paper payslips or your ePayslip via ePayroll. The link to Self Service: <https://workforce.mhs.scot.nhs.uk/eYou/Authentication/Login.aspx>.

If you do not know/have an NHS payroll number, you will be asked for your Surname, Date of Birth and Postcode to authenticate your identity. A helpful user guide to the new system is available online.

As well as the mass staff flu vaccination clinics, we are once again encouraging clinical staff to vaccinate their colleagues in their work area through peer vaccination; this is a quick and easy option for staff to receive this year's flu vaccine without having to leave their work area.
